Sentences to Read Pre & Post Tests

On the Curriculum CD, you will find easy to follow instructions and the tests themselves in each of the 5 volumes of lessons – the Pre Test at the beginning of each volume and the post test at the end.

The American Bible Society has prepared an informal test called the “Reading Skills Pre-Test.” It contains 30 example sentences taken from the Bible (Contemporary English Version). The student’s score is simply the number of the last sentence that he or she could read easily.

After the student has had Mission: Literacy reading lessons for 16 weeks or for 16 lessons over at least 8 weeks, he or she can then take the “Reading Skills Post-Test.” Like the Pre-Test, it has 30 sentences taken from the Bible. Again, the student’s score is simply the number of the last sentence that he or she could read easily. A student who has successfully completed the literacy program will have a higher score on this test than he or she had on the Pre-Test.

Remember to record each child’s pre and post test scores on the reporting sheet entitled: *Student Evaluation Report*

Student Folder

Each student should have a folder documenting change through such items as:

Pre and Post Test results

Written or drawn activities done in a lesson

Copies of school report cards

Notes about the student’s progress – from tutors, parents, school teachers, student, etc
